- i. Chair

  - BG queried status of bench, this has been delivered. At this point AH handed over a cheque for £500 received from Cameron developers. It was agreed that the bench already received should be placed with this donation and a second bench ordered

to hold a Friends of Red House Park plaque. CH, SV and SL are to meet and agree a siting for the bench and pass detail to LI who will write a letter of thanks.

#### 5. Red House Park

- i. Features of the Park

- A request has been made to hire out cricket square, at the moment no formal arrangement has been made but some increased use is expected.
